RALLYE DAY BATTLE RHYTHM

- **0900-1000- Check in, Breakfast, Network**

Park vehicles at DC Prime, check-in, grab complimentary breakfast, and meet your teammate.

- **1000-1030- Driver's Briefing**

Our CEO will go over the rules and regs.

- **1030-1130**

5-star departure, 45-second intervals between vehicles. 4-stars will go after the 5-star, and so on.

- **1130**

First vehicle arrives at Breaux Vineyards. Celebration in the Acadia room begins. Open to the public! There will be live music, raffles, merchandise, and a donation station.

- **1330**

Winning team (race leaderboard style) and raffles announced.

- **1500**

Ceremony unofficially complete.

Rallye Best Practices:

- **Have a Drop Off and Pick Up Plan**- This is mostly for navigators. Navigators will have to coordinate with someone to make sure they can get back to their vehicle after the end of the event. We actually recommend having someone drop you off in the morning and meeting you at Breaux for the celebration to alleviate this challenge.

- **Communicate**- While this is one of our easier designed rallyes, communication with your teammate is key. There are a few sections of the rallye that will need close attention and teamwork. We also add a couple of conversation starters in the navigator's envelope to keep the communication flowing during the drive.

- **Have fun!** - While there is technically a "winning" team, this is all for the experience and to raise money for veterans. The rallye time was calculated based on the legal speed limits. Please adjust your speeds accordingly based on that. Be cognizant of that, but also...have fun.
